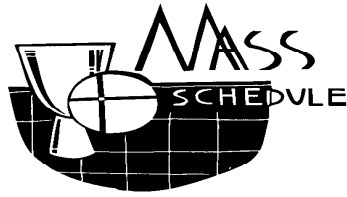
Next weekend we look forward to the First Communion of many of our young folks who will receive the Holy Eucharist with their families at all the Masses.

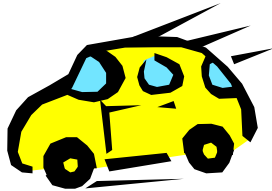

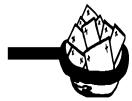
